Question re plagiarism – senior cycle – some subjects have more project work and assignments and are sent to examiners.

Question re going digital IPad/Tablet only – no plans to go in this direction.

Question re banning of phones – policy in place if see or hear phone it is taken off student until next day. No plans to ban them. Assemblies deal with phone usage and appropriate use of apps (Snapchat, Whatsapp, Instagram etc)

Colin shared link in chat re cyber safety.

Question re extracurricular – Mr Burke is point of contact and announcements made throughout the day.

Question re VSware and explanation that available in app form. 'Points' a good system for rewarding behaviour.

Question re book exchange – idea for Parents Association to run this along with uniform swap.

Poor take-up on 24-hour insurance so Mr. Ward will sent out a reminder. Sarah shared that the request for payment will be in parent's online payment portal.
